The Archibird Prize is a native bird photo/art competition held in the Cowra region NSW run by Cowra Council, NRM committee and Central Tablelands Local Land Services. The Archibird was launched in 2019 and is run in October aligned with National Bird week and Aussie backyard bird count.

We hope you all love and appreciate birds as much as we do, as they play an essential part in our ecosystem. Birds are amazing pollinators in helping your garden and nature grow by carrying and dispersing seeds.

There are some amazing prizes up for grabs. The categories for the Colouring in and Art include:

Kindergarten- Year 2: Colouring in & Art work

Year 3- 6: Colouring & Art work

Entrants may enter 1 piece in each of the categories eg, 1 colouring in and 1 art work in your age group.

Terms and Conditions

For Art, Sculpture & Colouring contest

- 1 entry per person per category
- Sculptures and Artworks must be of an Australian Native **Bird** only.
- Colouring in & Artwork categories are available for K-6.
- Sculptures must be no bigger than 30cm x 30cm
- Artworks must be no bigger than A4 size
- Artworks and colouring ins will be displayed in the Library, Civic Centre and/or Cowra Customer Service building after competition closes.
- Council will be collecting entries on the 1st November from schools, alternatively you can drop your entries to the Council Chambers.
- Please include name, school, year group & best contact information on the back of all entries.
