

Summary of decisions January 2023 Council Meeting

- Council noted the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding between Cowra Tourism and Cowra Council.
- The Delivery Program 2022-2023 to 2025-2026 Operational Plan 2022-2023 Six-Month Review to 31 December 2022 was noted.
- Release of Closed Decisions 295/22 –
 Request for Tender Replacement of Plant 91
 Rubber Tyred Wheel Loaded
- Council noted the Second Quarterly Budget Review for the quarter ended 31 December 2022.
- Council noted the Investments and Financial report for December 2022.
- Council will write to the Minister for Police and Regional NSW, Hon Paul Toole MP, Member for Cootamundra, Hon Steph Cooke MP, and Shadow Minister for Police, Paul Scully MP requesting that they advocate to the NSW state government to provide resources and staff to the Cowra Police Station and to ensure that our community can be provided with a 24-hour police station.

 Council will offer partial reimbursement for Aquatic Centre patrons who purchased season passes between 1 September 2022 and 13 November 2022. The reimbursement is to be the equivalent to the daily season pass cost for the 53 days that the Aquatic Centre was closed. Any Active Kids vouchers that were used to purchase a season pass are ineligible for reimbursement.
