

Summary of decisions November 2022 Council Meeting

- Council noted the correspondence received from the Mayor of Weddin Shire Council offering use of the Grenfell Aquatic Centre to Cowra Aquatic Centre season ticket holders. Council will write to the Mayor of Weddin Shire Council thanking him and accepting his offer.
- Council will write to the Prime Minister and NSW Premier supporting the call by Local Government NSW and Country Mayors Association of NSW in declaring a Statewide Road Emergency.
- Council adopted the Council meeting dates for 2023.
- Council noted the draft minutes of the Cowra Regional Art Gallery Advisory Committee meetings held on 14 September and 12 October 2022.
- Council noted the Investments and Financial Report for October 2022.
- Council noted the draft minutes of the Audit, Risk and Improvement Committee meeting held on 3 November 2022.
- Council noted the report from the Local Government Grants Commission.
- Council will provide a donation of \$500.00 from the Section 356 expenses budget to assist First Aid and Awareness Training for the installation of three defibrillators placed in Kendal Street, Cowra in 2022.
- Council noted the completion of the Financial Statements for the year ended 30 June 2022.

- Council noted the correspondence from the Local Government Remuneration Tribunal regarding the 2023 Annual Review and endorsed the submission presented in the report.

Council noted the draft minutes of the Traffic Committee meeting held on 17 October 2022 and the following actions:

- That two deciduous trees be removed from the southern end of the footpath in Lachlan Street to satisfy sight distance requirements north of the Vaux Street/Lachlan Street intersection.
- That a bollard fence and concrete blisters be installed on both sides of Vaux Street, at the intersection with Lachlan Street (refer plan titled 'Proposed Concrete Blister and Median Treatment Plan View Vaux Street Option 4' dated 25/07/2022) to attain an unprotected crossing distance of 16.5m between kerbs; subject to obtaining grant funding.
- That Council approves the Class I special event to be held by Cowra Tourism on 2 December 2022 subject to compliance with the requirements of Transport for NSW (TfNSW) and NSW Police.
- That the pedestrian crossing in Brisbane Street between Busby Place & Vaux Street, and the combination Pedestrian/Children's Crossing in Vaux Street between Brisbane Street & Macquarie Street be made compliant with AS 1742.10-2009 and RTA Technical Directions TDT2001/12c & TDT20011/01a.
- That that the matter of traffic congestion and queueing across the Cowra Bridge on the Mid Western Highway be referred to Transport for New South Wales (TfNSW) to investigate options at the Kendal Street Lachlan Street intersection.
- Council noted the draft minutes of the Tidy Towns Committee meetings held on 28 September and 26 October 2022.

- Development Application No. 96/2022, Lot 2 DP 1265783, 231 Elouera Road Cowra, transportable dwelling, lodged by Ammrad Pty Ltd T/A Lloyds Transportable Homes was approved with conditions.
- Council resolved to advise all declared political candidates of the requirements for Election Signage under the provisions of the State Environmental Planning Policy (Exempt and Complying Development Codes) 2008 and the Electoral Act 2017. Council reserves the right to undertake appropriate regulatory action should breaches of the aforementioned legislation occur.
