### WHAT CAN I DONATE?

**Donated goods must be in good condition, clean and have no damage. We gratefully accept the donation of:**

**BLANKETS:** Clean and in good condition, with no stains, holes or frayed edges. No electric blankets.

**BEACH AND BATH TOWELS:** Clean and in good condition, with no stains, holes or frayed edges.

**DRY AND WET FOOD:** In its original, intact packaging and within the expiry date. No raw food or bones.

**GOOD CRATES:** Large dog crates in good condition, no rust or broken parts.

**DOG COATS:** Clean and in good condition with no holes.

**DOG AND PUPPY TOYS:** Treat-dispensing toys, puzzle feeders, durable balls, rope toys and plush toys.

**CAT CARRIERS:** Cat carriers in good, working condition, no cracks or broken parts.

**CAT AND KITTEN TOYS:** Small plush toys.



## MATERIAL RECYCLING FACILITY GUIDELINES

Report to the weighbridge operator when entering the facility.

Customers are requested to observe and adhere to the speed limits and safety signs at all times.

Fully enclosed footwear must be worn at all times.

Children are to remain inside the vehicle.

Unauthorised scavenging is prohibited.

The site is monitored by video surveillance. Photos may be taken by waste management facility staff.

Customers not complying with directions from waste management facility operator/s will be requested to leave the site.
