- O Have a hanging system installed if wall hung.
- Artists must reside in a participating NetWaste Council in order to enter Waste 2 Art
- Coordinators will notify local Waste 2 Art winners.
- Judges and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.
- The Judges decision is final, no correspondence will be entered into.
- Artworks remain the property of the artist.
- Packaged artworks shall not exceed a size of 1 cubic meter or a weight of 30kgs (the work can be divided into separate packages to meet these requirements if assembly instructions are included)
- Images of artworks may be published by the organisers.
- Works which exceed the size or weight limit must be entered as photographs framed (not laminated) to A3 with D rings for hanging.
